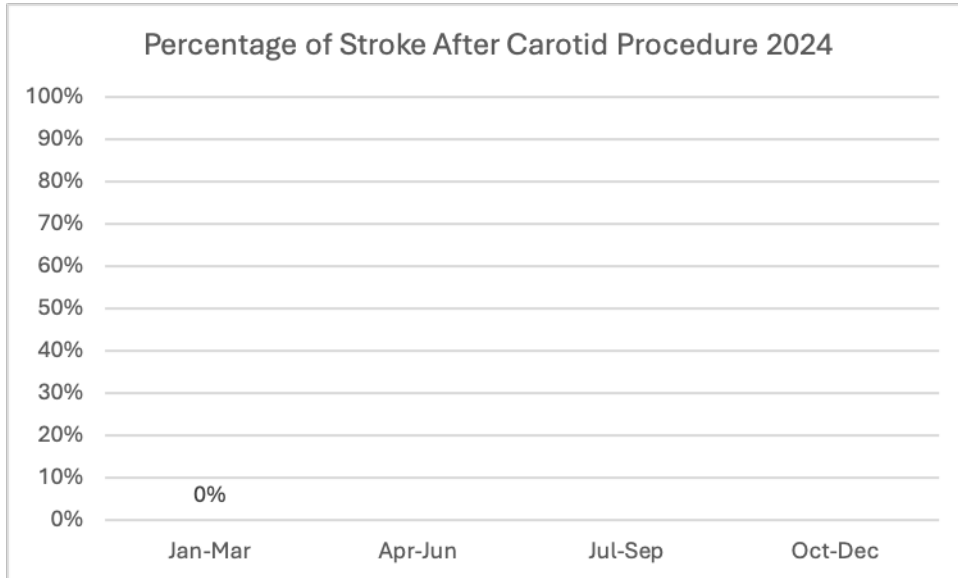
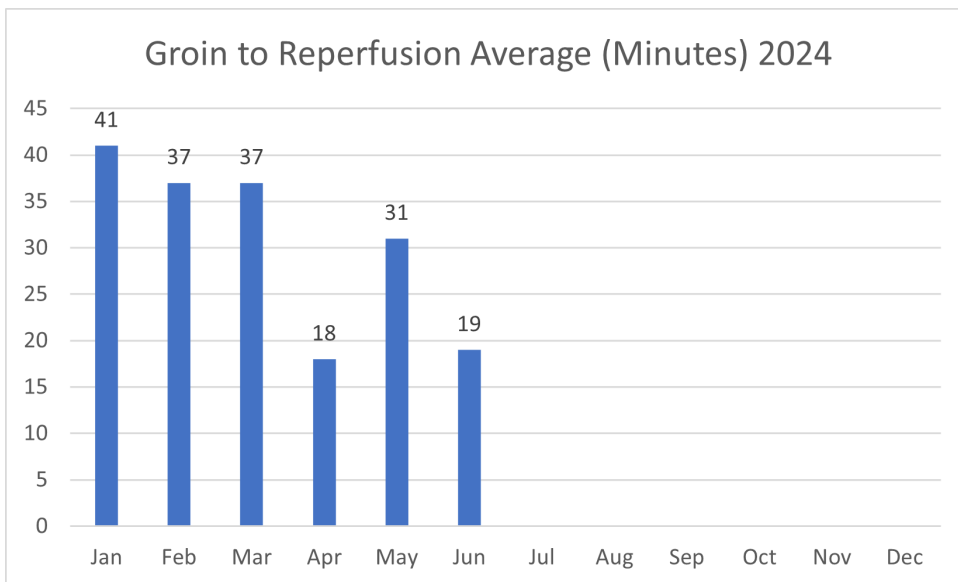


# STROKE PERFORMANCE MEASURES



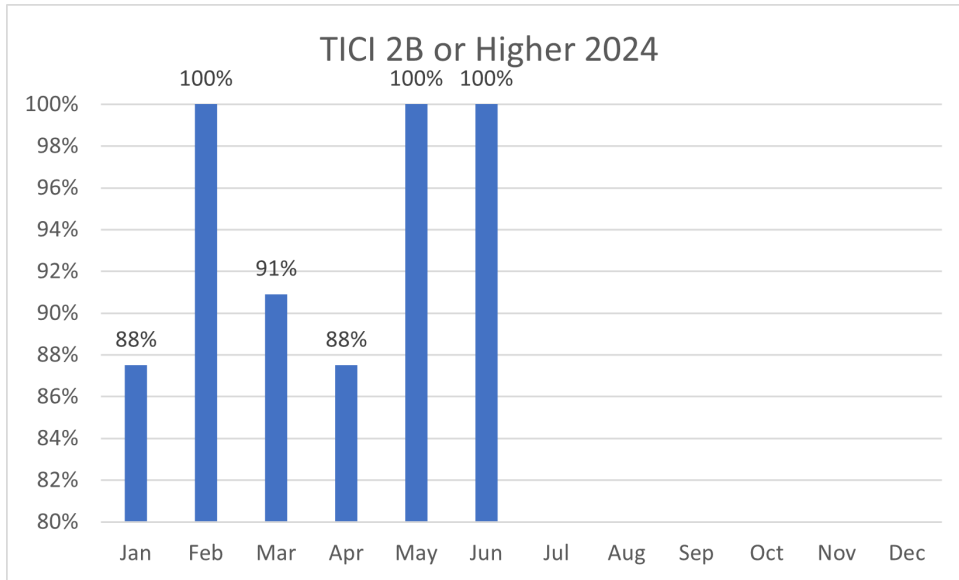
Carotid procedures include carotid stents, carotid endarterectomies, and transcarotid artery revascularization.

Stroke can be a complication of these procedures. There have been no strokes reported after any carotid procedures during January through March of 2024.



Thrombectomies remove large blood clots from the brain when a patient is suffering from a stroke. The goal is to remove this clot within one hour of groin puncture. January's average was 41 minutes, and 37 minutes for February and March. Faster times mean the potential for more brain saved.

# STROKE PERFORMANCE MEASURES



TICI score stands for thrombolysis in cerebral infarction. Patients who have a score of 2B or higher have complete filling of the vessels. This means the patient has a better chance at recovery after having a large clot removed from their brain.
