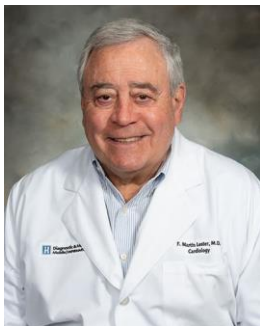
## GRAND ROUNDS
